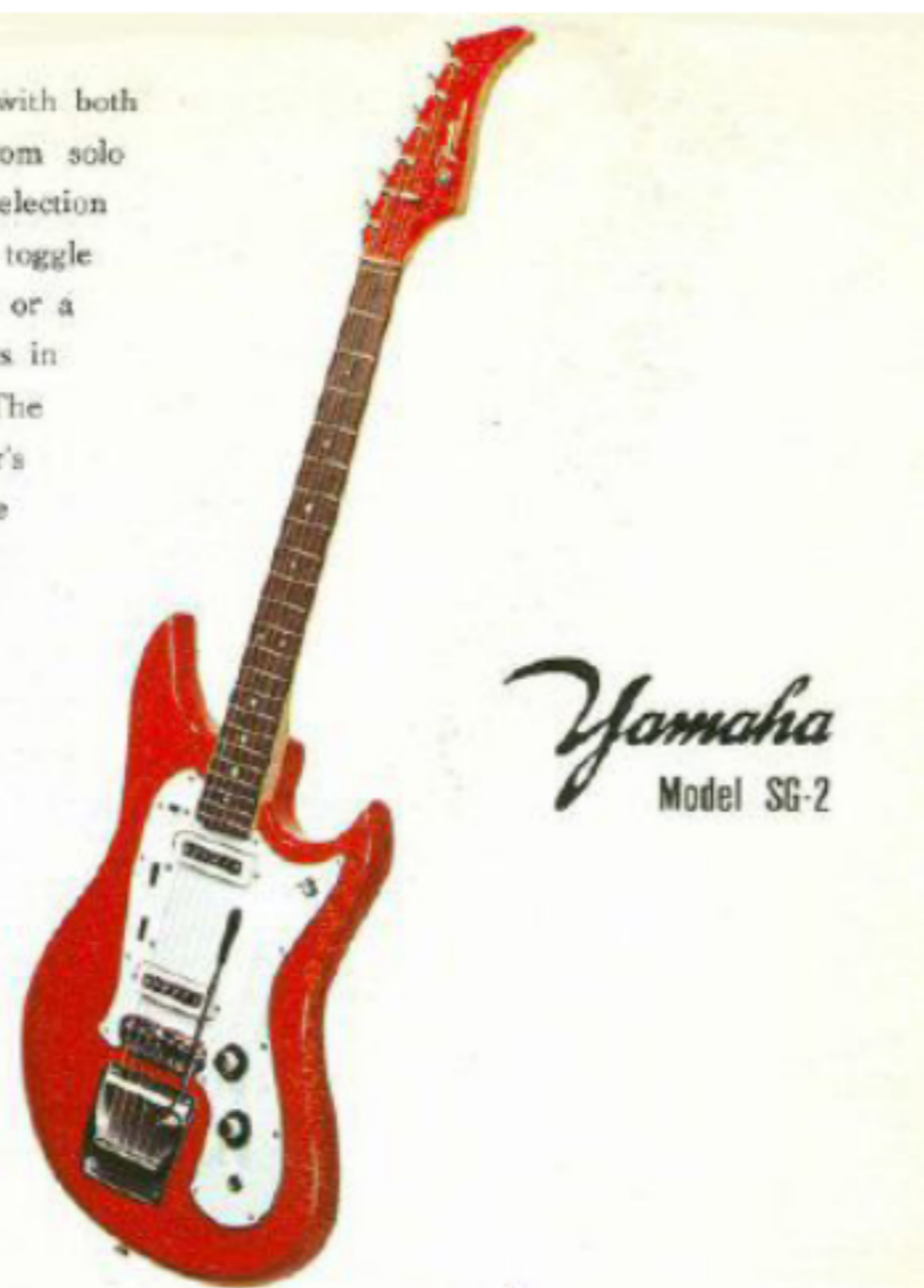
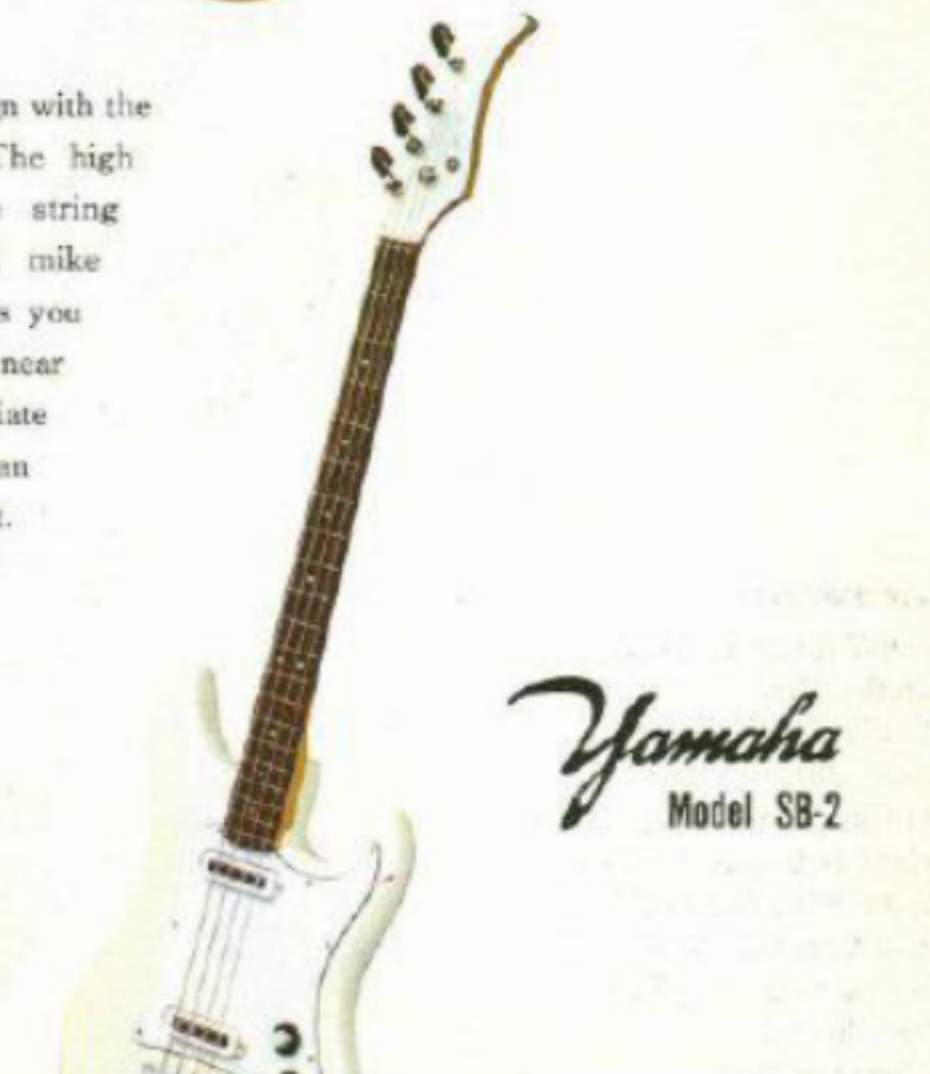


This Yamaha Electric Guitar Model SG-2 is extremely popular with both the solo and rhythm players. Tonal quality may be changed from solo to rhythm with the flick of a switch. Complete range of tonal selection is available in either the solo or rhythm settings. The pre-set toggle switch allows instant changes from one pick-up to the other or a combination of both. The new Anisotropic Ferrite Magnets in each pick-up assure a consistent tone at all levels of volume. The roller type bridge is fully adjustable to meet the individual player's requirements. A ball bearing action tremolo arm provides the performer with a soft touch movement that returns to the accurate pitch after use. The neck is made of select maple and is adjustable for easy regulation of the fingerboard action. The scale is 25 1/2". The body contour is shaped to form a comfortable playing position. High gloss polyester finishes are available in three popular colors at no additional cost: Coral Red, Pearl White, Sunburst. Chrome plated individual machine heads have modern designed metal buttons. 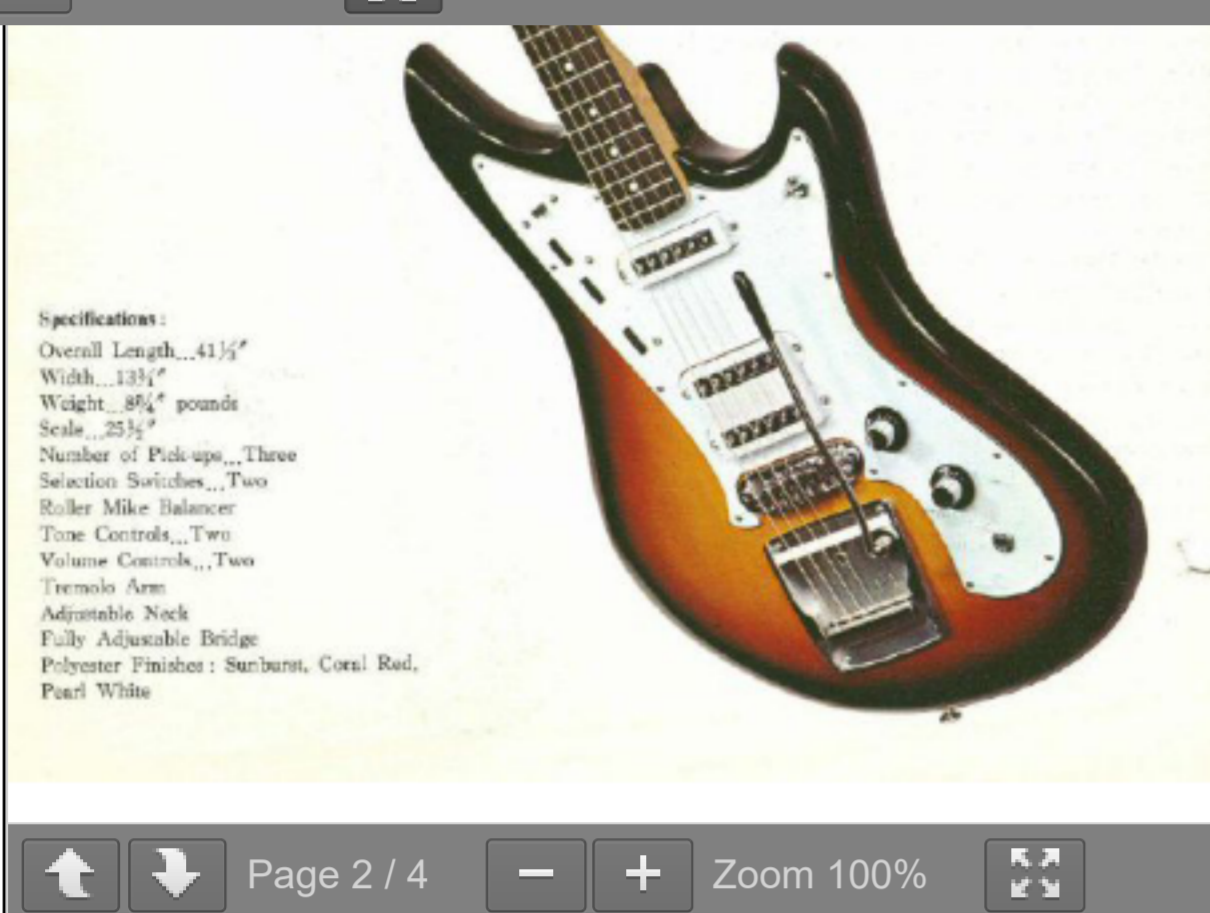

The Yamaha Electric Bass Guitar Model SB-2 is the latest design with the comfort-contoured body and a high gloss polyester finish. The high quality Anisotropy Ferrite Magnetic pick-ups produce the true string bass sound. Three controls are provided for volume, tone and mike balancer. The bottom control, called the mike balancer, enables you to set the desired tone quality by selecting either the pick-up near the fingerboard or the pick-up near the tailpiece or any intermediate setting between the two pick-ups, as you prefer. In addition an adjustable damper mute is incorporated in the tailpiece unit. The bridge is adjustable in height and forward and backward position. Select air and kiln dried maple is employed in the neck. The neck has 20 frets and is fully adjustable to fit the performer's needs. A three-ply pick guard plate enhances the beauty of the modern design. The machine heads are chrome plated with plastic buttons. Specially designed quality strings have been used. The overall length is 48". The width is 13 3/4". Three popular finishes are available at no additional cost: Coral Red, Pearl White, Sunburst. Price : \$ 219.50
